From the Manager...

On February 1, 2008, the President declared a major disaster in Kansas and ordered federal aid to supplement state and local recovery efforts in the areas struck by winter storms from Dec. 6-19, 2007. This disaster declaration means that Twin Valley will be eligible for payment of not less than 75 percent of the eligible costs for repairing or replacing our damaged facilities that occurred as a result of the Dec. 9 ice storm. The state will contribute an additional 10 percent toward those costs.

Our engineers have surveyed the damaged areas and are preparing cost estimates showing what work needs to be done to restore the facilities to our current construction standards. Our preliminary damage assessment was over \$4 million in Labette County and \$330,000 in Cherokee County. Most of this work will be put out for bid in the near future.

We have had many inquiries about standby generators since the ice storm. In our last newsletter we offered a special deal on the transfer switches necessary to operate standby generators safely. We would encourage each of you to consider installing a transfer switch so that you could hook up a standby generator if your power

was ever disrupted as the result of a storm. We will upgrade your meter loop to include the transfer switch for \$250.

We continue to explore possibilities to bring economic expansion and growth into our service area. We would like to attract some new loads that have a high load factor (those that use a constant amount of power for 24-hours per day, 365 days per year). New loads would improve our load factor, which benefits all of our members by lowering our average cost of power.

The methane gas well development has helped us keep our wholesale cost of power stable over the last two years. We are planning to add another 150 gas well services this year in the southwest portion of our service area. We will be building more three phase lines to provide electric service to these wells. We try to recover all of the line construction costs in advance from the gas companies as we do not want to be burdened with stranded investment costs in the future should the gas wells not operate at today's level.
